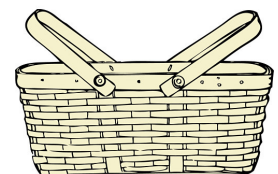

Relax while listening to some great music and enjoying a picnic meal. BYO-food and beverage (lemonade and popcorn are available for purchase).



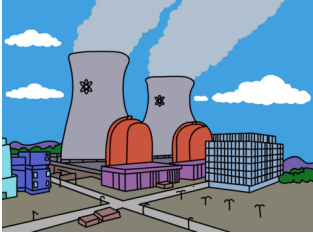
